Lessons and Method

Holidays can be fun and practical all at once... Berlitz Camps combine active language training with great leisure activities. Your kids or teenagers will learn German while having a lot of fun at the same time.

At Berlitz Camps holidays turn into an adventure and best of all, German, being heard and spoken everywhere at all times, is learned and retained effortlessly. Our native trainers introduce the children to the German language in various projects and workshops in keeping with the principle of learning by doing. Whether during morning lessons, while doing crafts, painting, singing, dancing or playing sports in the afternoon, there is no way of getting away from the new language. Everything just comes so easy to children...

Learning a foreign language is never as easy as in childhood. Full of curiosity, children quite naturally immerse themselves into a new language. The chances of them being able to speak without an accent are all the greater the earlier they start to learn. Furthermore, our experience shows how much fun young campers have and how proudly, confidently and naturally they practice their new language.

All language instructors on the Berlitz Kids & Teens programs are native speakers and have experience working with children.

Facilities at the Camp

The large sports campus with a variety of different possibilities includes an international tennis academy. There are also indoor courts, a judo hall and a spa area. The campus is located next to the local public swimming pool and the golf course and riding stables are nearby.

Dates

Duration: 1 or 2 weeks

Week 1: Sunday-Saturday, July 29th - August 4th 2012

Week 2: Sunday-Saturday, August 5th - August 11th 2012

Optional: Extension from 1st to 2nd week

Accommodation: 3-4 kids per room with ensuite bathroom (shower and toilet)



Meals:

Full board including breakfast, lunch and a dinner buffet (including fruit juices; vegetarian option available)

Target Group:

Kids and teens aged 10-16 with previous knowledge of German (online placement of previous German knowledge in advance and checked orally at the start of camp)

Sports:

Daily classes in tennis, horse-riding or golf (Monday to Friday) from approx. 2-4pm. 1 type of sport is chosen for the entire stay (the participant's choice of sport can be changed for the 2nd week).

Tennis:

The lessons take place at the Styrian tennis academy offering 4 indoor courts (carpet granulate) and 5 outdoor courts (sand). The kids are offered one hour with the trainer and 1 hour practice within the group per day.

Horse-riding:

The riding stables are located nearby and the transfer, which takes a maximum of 10 minutes, is organised by Berlitz. The kids are offered 1 lesson with the trainer every day and take care of the horses the remaining time. Beginners practice on the lunge, whereas those who are advanced ride in the riding ring. Participants go hacking once a week (organised depending on the weather).

Golf at Golfclub Murstätten:

Surrounded by green meadows this spacious golf course with its 14 hectare lake, various bunkers and greens can be compared to a Scottish golf links and challenges the advanced golfers as well. Additionally a 9-hole-compact course with practise facilities and the completion of the "ÖGV junior pass" is offered for the beginners.

Leisure Activities and Evening Program:

Swimming in the open-air swimming pool, archery, beach volleyball, handball, basketball, minigolf, an intercultural evening, DVD evening, disco, games, treasure hunt and quiz are all an offer.

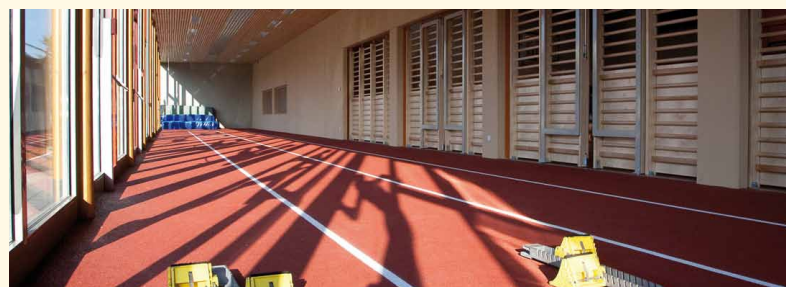
Weekend Program (Obligatory when booking 2 consecutive weeks)

Saturday: Sightseeing trip to Graz with a city tour visiting the most famous sights (e.g. the Schlossberg, Mur island, Kunsthau (art gallery)), picnic in the city park (depending on the weather), shopping options in the old town, dinner in a "Buschenschank" (a typical Styrian restaurant) and a torch hike.

Sunday: Adventure Program: Styrian Olympics or swimming afternoon, a lunchbox at noon, then dinner at the camp.

Basic rate for 1 week	€ 740
Extension week (Booking in advance)	€ 640
